Items were taken out of order from the agenda.

3233 Public Speaking - Residents of St Julians Wells Kirk Ella, attended the meeting to ask for help to stop further telecommunications poles being installed by MS3 Networks on St Julians Wells. Gill Locking, who had successfully campaigned to have some poles removed in West Ella, had very kindly agreed to assist with their campaign. It was agreed a letter of objection be sent to MS3 Networks from the Parish Council Chairman and Cllr. G. McMaster agreed to contact MP Emma Hardy for her support.

3234 Chairman's Opening Remarks - The Chairman thanked Cllrs. B. Weeks, R. Weeks and the Clerk for meeting with E.R.Y.C. Officers to discuss the Parish Council Christmas event. The Clerk was also thanked for removing the D-Day flags from the parish noticeboards. Members were reminded to let the Clerk know of any planned annual leave.

3237 Law & Order - PC Ollie Turner attended the meeting to brief members on reported incidents since 1st June. Residents are encouraged to sign up to 'My Community Alert' and reminded to report all incidents. There is currently a serious problem occurring in the Gorton Road area, youths throwing stones at moving vehicles, causing damage and potential accidents. PC Turner had visited Wolfreton School to discuss Youth Justice and criminal damage. (Youth Justice prevents offending and re-offending by children and young people by working with them, their parents and carers). Youths need to consider the consequences of having a criminal record.

3238 Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 10th June 2024 - The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 10th June 2024 were accepted as a true record of what took place and duly signed by the Chairman.

3239 Matters Arising from the Minutes

Minute 3225 (3213e) - Cllr. G. McMaster reported that following an onsite meeting with E.R.Y.C. Highways, figures showed the average speed of vehicles travelling around the corner on Packman Lane is 24mph, 4-6% of cars were driving over 30mph but were under the enforceable limit. Statistics show there is not a speeding problem on Packman Lane. Cllr. G. McMaster to respond to the resident who had raised the issue.

Minute 3225 (3213d) - The Chairman had spoken to the resident who'd made the existing Little Free Library and confirmed he was happy to build a bigger library for the Parish Council and was also in agreement with the installation of a seat. It was advised that the Love Your High Street grant which funded the previous library is no longer available. Clerk to confirm ownership of the land where the library currently sits.

Minute 3225 (3211) - The Clerk had delivered the portrait of His Majesty the King to Kirk Ella St Andrew's CP School.



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Minute 3227b - The Clerk reported that the Community Speed Watch Coordinator had left Humberside Police force and it is likely to be a few months before a replacement is appointed. A list of outstanding areas looking to set up a scheme had been forwarded to Inspector Hutchins, Road Policing Unit.

Minute 3227f - Thanks had been received from the Minster Rail Campaign Committee for the letter supporting the principle of the project.

- b) Application by Doggerbank Offshore Wind Farm, Project 4 Proico Limited - Received, no comment to make.
- c) Proposed Peartree Hill Solar Farm Consultation on proposed Application for development consent - Received, no comment to make.
- d) Expression of Interest – 20mph Speed Limit Trial - A letter had been received advising that E.R.Y.C.'s Cabinet passed a motion in October 2023 to undertake a trial of 20mph zones across the East Riding with a reserved amount of £80k set aside in the new 2024/25 financial budget. Four sites would be looked at initially, each allocated £20k, if the scheme estimate is more than the allocation then the Parish/Town Council must meet the additional cost. The 20mph speed limit is currently not enforceable.

3242 Events

- a) Update on Christmas 2024 - Cllr. R. Weeks updated members on arrangements so far and the positive meeting held with E.R.Y.C. Officers. The application for a road closure is ongoing, Cllr. G. McMaster to speak to GRAHAM (Consulting Engineers) about managing the road closure on our behalf. It is hoped to make a booking with a fairground which would be set up in The Wheatsheaf car park. Invitations will be sent out shortly to potential stallholders. The next meeting of the Events Working Group is planned for Tuesday 9th July.

 - Conversion of garage to create additional living accommodation - 20 West Ella Way, Kirk Ella - **GRANTED** (*PC response no comment*).
