

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary election
for the following constituencies:

Beverley and Holderness
East Yorkshire
Haltemprice and Howden

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve in each of the above constituencies.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the (Acting) Returning Officer, County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA or can be downloaded from www.eastriding.gov.uk/candidates.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Thursday 11 May.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender, debit or credit card or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 8 June.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 22 May.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA by 5pm on Tuesday 23 May.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA by 5pm on Wednesday 31 May.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA by 5pm on Thursday 8 June. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May.
