**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)**  
**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC**  
**Beverley Road Anlaby (part of):**

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Beverley Road Anlaby (part of) from 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

The closure site begins at the junction of Lowfield Road and extends southwards for a distance of approximately 100 meters. This closure is necessary to enable workman to safely undertake works required for the Anlaby and East Ella Flood Alleviation Scheme and to ensure that these works can be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that these works will be completed by 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017.

**The alternative route for all traffic is via Boothferry Road, A164, Tranby Lane, and Beverley Road and vice versa. Access will be provided for pedestrians and emergency services at all times.**
