ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
WOODLAND DRIVE (PART OF) ANLABY

In accordance with the East Riding of Yorkshire Council Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order 2017 notice is hereby given that East Riding of Yorkshire Council is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Woodland Drive (from its junction with Beverley Road and extending westwards for approximately 30metres, commencing 8th November 2017.

This closure is necessary to enable workman to safely undertake works required for the Anlaby and East Ella Flood Alleviation Scheme and to ensure that these works can be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. It is anticipated that these works will be completed by 23rd January 2018.

The alternative route for all traffic is via Woodland Drive, Broadley Avenue, South Ella Way, Beverley Road, Tranby Lane, Croft View and vice versa. Access will be provided for pedestrians and emergency services at all times.
