ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Tranby Lane, Anlaby

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Tranby Lane, Anlaby between Swanland Roundabout and after Jenny Brough Lane commencing 19th April 2021 to allow works for the safe implementation of highway construction works to create a 'Right Turn Lane' in to Jenny Brough Lane from Tranby Lane.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 33 days.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Humber Bridge Northern Approach Road, Humber Bridge Roundabout, Boothferry Road, Boothferry Road Roundabout, Beverley Road and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for residents.
